Belonging

Year 1:

To know there are a range of festivals through the year that are linked to different religions or beliefs.

To know that the people who belong to these cultures and religions have a sense of belonging and family.

F2/Reception:

To know that I have similarities and differences that connect me to and distinguish me from others.

To know that we make friends by helping each other, being kind and sharing.

To know about people who help us and how they help us.

To know that every family has rules.

To know that we belong to the Healdswood family and we follow the Healdswood Agreements.

To know that Christians follow a set of rules because they are part of God's family.

Year 2:

To know that belonging means feeling included in a group. *E.g family, school, club*

To know that you belong in your family, each member has a role *e.g mum, dad, brother etc.*

To know that individuals belong to other parts of the community *e.g clubs, school*

To know that Christians often show they belong being baptised.

To know the story of Jesus being baptised in the River Jordan.

To know that People who believe in God belong to a religious family.

To know that they share the same beliefs of that religion.

To know that Christians follow an agreement which is part of the ten commandments. ('do to others what you would like them to do to you') and belonging to humanity.
